

Table-These high-endbeautiful tables with riser arebuilt by Reeve for DKNY todisplay their lingerie withinNordstrom stores. The solidmetal bar frame is a satinchrome finish with frostedglass tops.





Lord & Taylor- Shoe Risers-Stainless steel sheet metal and bar stock is transformed into these unique and functional shoe display risers. Several different heights were made by Reeve for this high-end retailer.





Charlotte Russe—The glass dump table with wood end tables, glass risers with laser cut metal bases (above) and the tall showcase with two wood tables (below) were all made by Reeve for Charlotte Russe.





This rolling dump table with two metal shelves, wood top, and side pullouts makes an excellent seasonal or promotional display. Reeve manufactures a wide variety of metal racks including Rounders and Two-Ways. These dull nickel brushed chrome racks were produced for The Children's Place.

A classic base consisting of a chrome inlay and square top plate.




A round piece of black acrylic wrapped in copper plated metal creates a unique look to this mirror.

Reeve will not charge a set-up fee for any of these finishes, no matter what quantity you order. Actual samples of plated finishes are available upon request. Reeve can also manufacture using stainless steel. Some variations in shade and texture may occur in production.







Voriety of Powder Coat Finishes



At left are samplings of the many hundreds of powder coat finishes available from Reeve. Just supply us with a powder manufacturer's name and product number or an actual sample, and we will do the rest. Some finishes require a minimum purchase quantity.

Actual samples of powder coat finishes are available upon request. Reeve can also manufacture using **stainless steel.** Some variations in shade and texture may occur in production.

Strength & Gauges of Reeve Metal

The strength of a metal is one of its most important characteristics. The term "strength" sums up several of its attributes enabling it to withstand stresses without failing. There are several classifications of strength including tensile strength, temper, yield strength, shear strength, bearing strength, and hardness. All products manufactured by Reeve Store Equipment Co. meet or exceed the specifications published by the National Association of Store Fixture Manufacturers (NASFM). Characteristics of specific parts are available on request.

Reeve Store Equipment Co. utilizes several different thicknesses of steel sheet and wire. The following tables list those different thicknesses (or "gauges") showing the corresponding gauge to thickness in inches (shown as decimals):
