


## Reeve Store Equipment Co.

As a retailer in the early 1900's, Hurum E. Reeve found it difficult to find quality store fixtures for his Torrance, California hardware store. Being a resourceful and talented entrepreneur he began making his own store fixtures. It did not take long to realize that his "side business" not only could serve his needs but those of other retailers as well, so by the late 1920's his new Hurum E. Reeve Co. became his first priority. By 1931 his new company was building strong, versatile high quality metal store fixtures for retailers on the economically booming West Coast. The company's first products included Glass Binning Hardware and what would become the Universal Line of stock hardware.

Hurum's son, Edgar Holland Reeve, took over the reins in 1938 and concentrated on building both the company's market base and product line while maintaining the tradition of quality, strength, and versatility. During his 44 years as President of the Reeve Co., he created a national network of exclusive independent Distributors that peaked in the 1970's with well over 150 separate locations.
